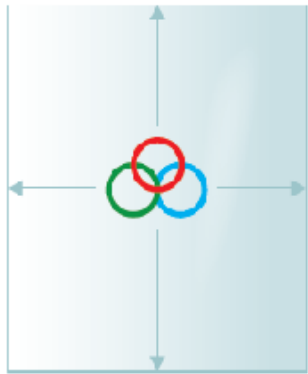

## Choose type of printing

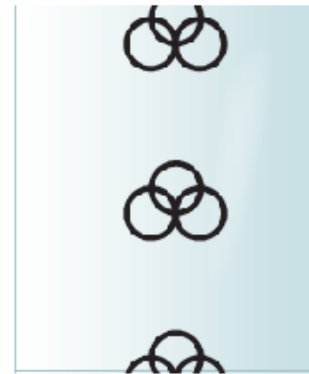
### Registered

### Random Repeat

Choose Random Repeat Printing when the position of your artwork is flexible and you only need one color. We guarantee 1 complete image will be printed on your product.

PRINTABLE AREA

We've kept "Get a quick quote..." We've taken out the "upload your complete schematic" option (for Release 1).

We thought users might puzzle over what "Create my product" means and where that will take you. True, the print designer in the background offers some hints, and you can click the "Create my product" and find out, but we'd like to try seeing the how displaying the full range of options feels and if it is any more (or less) effective in getting users over that initial hump, and getting them to comprehend the available options.

Once you choose one of these plate sets, you may choose to modify the size or color of the artwork in our Designer. If you do, we may need to create a new plate set for this print job at the time of purchase, for which there is a one-time setup fee and some additional lead time. Otherwise, you'll be able to reuse the plate set at no additional charge, with normal product lead time.

PRINTABLE AREA

Taking a stab here at re-introducing the plate terminology, as well as language explaining how the plates can be reused, or used instead as a starting point for new plates. Also, introduced the concept of "plate sets" for registered printing, and captioning the artwork with number of plates created for the last print job based on # of colors.
